



Regulations on transport and traffic safety training for drivers are about to take effect

Ministry of Transport promulgates the Circular No. 12/2020/TT-BGTVT regulating organization and management of motor vehicle transportation services and road transport supporting services.

The Circular prescribes that transportation and traffic safety training for drivers and assistants will be provided, specifically including:

- Trainees: drivers and assistants working aboard.
- Training program adopts the training framework issued by the Ministry of Transport.
- Training schedule:
 - + Before participation in transportation service business;
 - + Held periodically at the 3 years' maximum interval between two training sessions.
- Trainers, including:
 - + Lecturers in the transportation major from (post)secondary or higher-level education institutions providing land transportation training programs; persons obtaining at least postsecondary diplomas in the transportation major;
 - + Persons holding associate or undergraduate degrees in other majors and acquiring at least 3 years' experience in management and administration of road transportation.
- Transportation units are responsible for organizing transportation and traffic safety training for their drivers and assistants working onboard,...

Circular No.12/2020/TT-BGTVT is entering into force from July 15, 2020.

Classification schedule of security products available for use from August 1, 2020

The Government promulgates the Decree No. 63/2020/ND-CP dated June 8, 2020, prescribing the security industry.

According to this document, the classification schedule of security products includes the following groups:

- Specialized security group, including 10 products as follows:
 - + Specialized and dedicated security support accessories;



- + Security and national defense weapons and explosive materials;
- + Security and national defense arms;
- + Special armored vehicles, technical accessories specially designed for security purposes;...
- Dual-use security group, including 09 products as follows:
 - + Special and dedicated materials, supplies; special-use military equipment.
 - + Political documents, records and newspapers, specialized magazines, forms and templates, anti-counterfeit stickers;
 - + Technical and professional means and equipment;
 - + Chemical, biological and testing appliances and products;...

Decree No. 63/2020/ND-CP is entering into force on August 1, 2020.

Amending regulations on requirements for recognition of bonded warehouses

Government promulgates the Decree No. 67/2020/ND-CP amending the Decree No. 68/2016/ND-CP regarding requirements for business of duty-free goods, storage facilities, locations for completion of customs clearance procedures, commodity gathering, customs inspection and supervision.

According to this document, regulations on requirements for recognition of bonded warehouses Amending regulations on requirements for recognition of bonded warehouses which are laid down in Article 10 of the 2016 Decree No. 68 will be amended and supplemented.

For instance, requirements concerning the size of a bonded warehouse are amended as follows:

- Each bonded warehouse located within the boundaries of a seaport, inland waterway port, inland clearance depot, international airport terminal or international railway station must have a storage facility covering the minimum area of 1,000 m²;
- Each special-use bonded warehouse must have a storage facility which covers the minimum area of 1,000 m² and has the minimum volume capacity of 1,000 m³;
- Each bonded warehouse located within the boundaries of an industrial zone must occupy a land plot covering the minimum area of 4,000 m² (including freight storage warehouses, yards



and other supporting structures), especially the storage facility that covers a minimum area of 1,000 m²;

- Any bonded warehouse other than those mentioned above must occupy a land plot covering a minimum area of 5,000 m² (including freight storage warehouses, yards and other supporting structures), especially the storage facility that covers a minimum area of 1,000 m²;

A bonded yard must cover a minimum area of 10,000 m² while none of requirements will be imposed on its storage facility.

Decree No. 67/2020/ND-CP is entering into force on August 10, 2020.
